JEFF BROWN

Bass Guitar/Vocals Founder member 2005 Jeff always knew he wanted to play bass and become a top performer. He realised this ambition when, for 16 years, he was lead singer and played bass guitar with The Sweet. His rock style vocals and varied style of bass playing have also given rise to a varied career playing with many different artists including amongst others, Alan Silson (original Smokie), Ian Gillan (Deep Purple), John Coghlan (Status Quo), and John Lawton (Uriah Heap). Jeff is currently an active member of The Trems (ex Tremeloes), and Cats In Space. He's a songwriter too, having released an album of his own cathartic life songs in 2015.

PHIL HENDRIKS

Guitar/Vocals
Joined 2011

Phil's career began as lead singer, songwriter and guitarist with power pop band The Stiffs, who enjoyed chart success with several hits. He's toured both in the UK and abroad with Eric Faulkner's Bay City Rollers from 2008 until 2011 when he became the regular touring guitarist with Les McKeown's Bay City Rollers until Les' sad death in 2021. Phil performs with Phil Wright's Original 70's Paper Lace and as touring guitarist with Merrill Osmond (lead singer of "The Osmonds"), whilst also pursuing a career as a recording artist in his own right. His solo album was released in 2020.

PETE PHIPPS

Drums/Vocals

Pete Phipps is the power house behind the Band, best known in the 70's as the heart-throb teen idol original drummer with Gary Glitter, and also in their own right, The Glitter Band. Later in the 80's he was drummer with The Eurythmics, XTC and Boy George as well as working with other high profile artists both on the road and in the recording studio. Pete is able to play in a wide range of styles and genres, and always has the enthusiasm to try something unusual and new. He still performs regularly with both The Glitter Band and the recently reformed Mud. Pete also released a solo album in 2020.

DAVE MAJOR Keyboards/Vocals Joined 2015

The youngest member of the Band and a classically trained pianist and keyboard player, Dave has a wealth of live experience. His playing credentials include working with Mickey Finn's re-formed T-Rex. He also plays with Phil Wright's Paper Lace, and the late Les McKeown's Bay City Rollers touring Band, the Legendaries. He's no stranger to creating projects as a session musician, and has a Music Technology Degree which has opened the door to music production and song writing, penning tracks for Eurovision and Pop Idol. He has also had a hand in producing a low frequency sound spectrum for Chakra meditation.
